*Go to the Library and Choose your Monument. Make sure you can get a book from our library or the town library for the monument you would like to research.

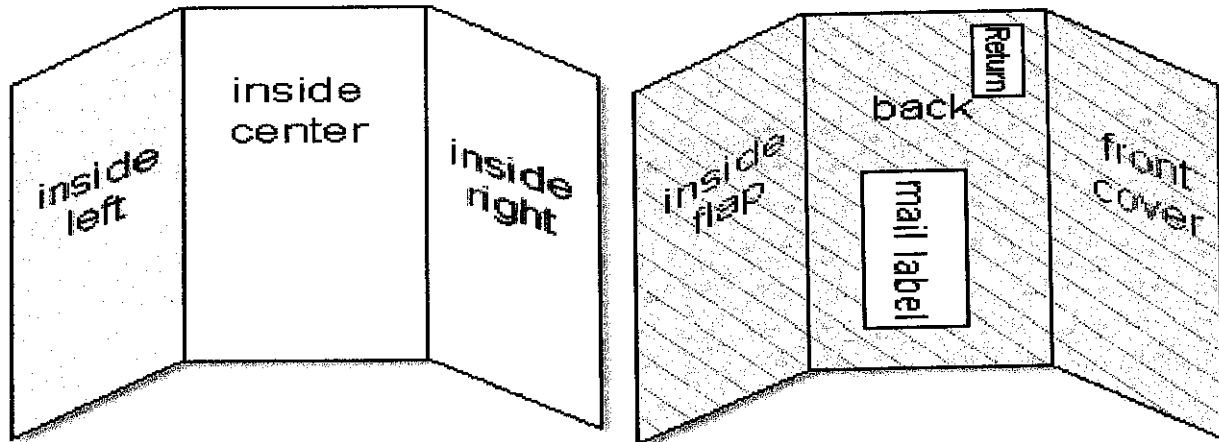
*Tell Mrs. Ridley on or before **May 12** what Monument you would like to research.

<p align="center">Overall neatness of brochure:</p> <p>-Colorful, well written, written on lined paper first or typed</p>	15	
<p align="center">Introduce your monument:</p> <p>-Why would someone want to visit your monument? Give a great hook that makes the reader want to visit. It should be creative. You should also include the title of your book here as well as the author.</p>	5 points (grabbing the reader) 5 points author/title	
<p align="center">Why did you chose this monument:</p> <p>Use your writing skills to tell the reader why you chose this monument. It should be at least 7 sentences.</p>	10	
<p align="center">History:</p> <p>Write two paragraphs about the monument's history. Each paragraph needs to be 7-8 sentences. Remember to use sentence variety and elaborative detail in your writing.</p>	40	
<p align="center">Important Facts:</p> <p>Five complete sentences telling important facts about your monument. You can use bullet points but make sure you are writing sentences</p>	10	
<p align="center">Photos:</p> <p>Include at least 3 pictures of your monument. (printed or drawn)</p>	10
